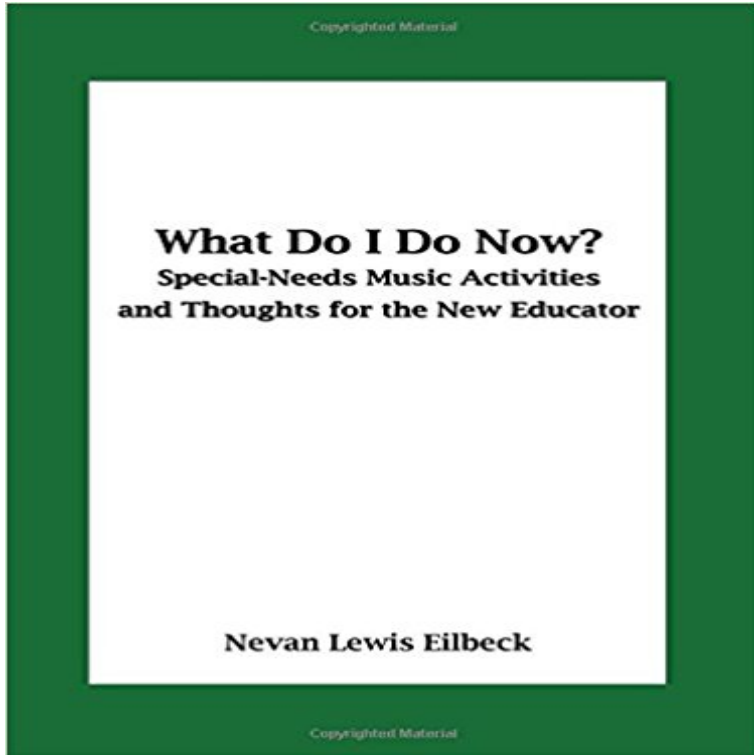


What Do I Do Now? Special-Needs Music Activities and Thoughts for the New Educator
