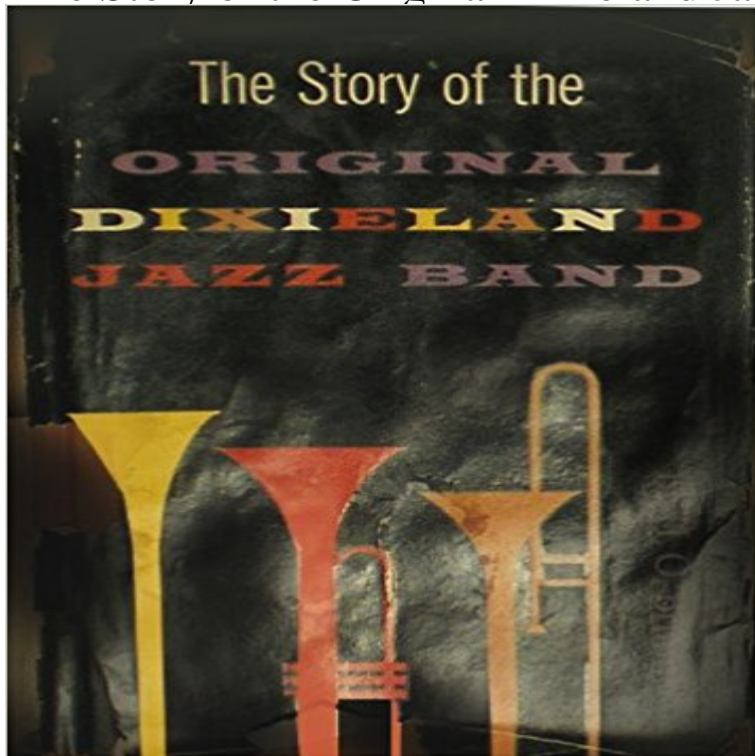


The Story of the Original Dixieland Jazz Band



On a bitter cold night in January, 1917, five laughing young men mounted the orchestra stand at Reisenwebers Restaurant in New York City and began an engagement that changed the course of American music. They were the Original Dixieland Jazz Band from New Orleans, and they introduced a music of their own creation--jazz. As a new form of music, it was revolutionary. It shocked, frightened, confused, and finally captivated the listener. Their first recording of jazz sold over a million copies; the Dixieland Band became nationally famous within a few months. In all parts of the country, the commercial possibilities of their music were immediately recognized by enterprising orchestra leaders, who converted from ragtime to jazz almost overnight. Jazz was exploited at a dizzy pace, and although it existed in its pure form for only a few years, it became the basis for the various styles of dance music that followed. The phenomenal success of the Dixieland Jazz Band obscured all other bands of the period. The most highly paid dance orchestra in the world, they were noted as an ensemble their fortune depended upon their original combination. Today, after more than four decades, the Dixieland Band has become almost legendary; and though few people remember anything about it, nearly everyone has heard of it.
